

PARKS & OPEN SPACES

The City of Coral Gables Neighborhood Renaissance Program was created with the purpose of improving the quality of life by investing in the City's neighborhoods. One of the facets of this program was to acquire properties in order for them to be used as public parks for the surrounding residents. Through this program, the City has purchased five properties and is undergoing a community input process in order to design a park that distinctly meets the needs of the surrounding neighborhood community.

Lisbon Park, on 1015 Lisbon Street, is a 10,500 square foot park space featuring lush landscaping, a rubberized walkway, a fountain feature, and other amenities all centered around a large majestic oak tree at the center of the property.

Catalonia Park is a 13,464 square foot lot that was purchased by the city located at 807 Catalonia Avenue. This property was known in the surrounding neighborhood as "Turtle Park" because of a decorative turtle statue that was once on the property. Through community input, the design will incorporate a feature that will continue this legacy.

Sarto Green Space – Located at 241 Sarto, is a 5,000 square foot lot at the corner of Salzedo Street and Sarto Avenue. The City is working with the community to provide a passive green space for the neighborhood.

Majorca Park – The property located at 939 Majorca Avenue is a 14,300 square foot lot. It is located near several prominent City landmarks including the Coral Gables Country Club, the Granada Golf Course and the fountain at Alhambra Plaza. This space will focus on the community's desire to provide a park space that signifies the city's culture and history while providing amenities to all ages of the community.

Venetia Park – A property located in the Northwest section of the City at 1047 Venetia Avenue. The lot is 8,250 square feet and has unique features including access from the north and south and a position at the end of a street. The City is working with the community to provide a park that serves as a neighborhood meeting place for its residents.

Marlin Park – This property is the largest lot purchased at 24,300 square feet. Located at 6540 Marlin Drive, this property will provide a park space to the King's Bay community in the southernmost part of the City. The City is working with the community to provide a park that meets the community's needs with a space featuring several different amenities.
